ScotRail is a key part of Scotland's wider transport network. We work with a range of operators to provide connections with other transport modes, including bus, ferry, subway, tram and airport links. For many journeys, combined tickets are available for travel on rail and other modes. Cycles

We carry cycles, subject to certain size and type restrictions, free on our trains. Please check our website in advance to confirm that your cycle can be carried and also to see if reservations apply on your chosen journey. Reservations are required on some longer distance routes and can be made online at www.scotrail.co.uk, by calling 0344 811 0141, or at many ticket offices. Find out more, including routes where a cycle reservation is required, at www.scotrail.co.uk/cycling

Help us to make your journey as safe as possible

Ensure that you give yourself enough time to catch your train and never try to board or leave a train while the doors are closing or the train is starting to move – please note that train doors close 30 seconds prior to departure time. If the door warning

is sounding, it is too late to board or alight the train. Remember to mind the gap when boarding and alighting. Please take the time to read the safety notices on-train and keep your luggage with you at all times. Please note that trains may divide en route – check with staff that you are in the correct portion of the train.

Alcohol

We want everyone who travels with us to be able to do so in a safe and friendly environment. Alcohol will not be allowed in our stations and on our trains, and people showing specific signs of intoxication will not be permitted to travel. The British Transport Police (BTP) support this decision.

E-Scooters

We have a temporary ban on the carrying of unregulated lithium-ion powered e-scooters, e-unicycles, e-skateboards and e-hoverboards in all ScotRail managed stations and on all ScotRail service. This ban will be reviewed by June 2024 but may be subject to an earlier review if further information comes to light in relation to the risk.

This policy does not apply to personal mobility devices, powered wheelchairs and power assisted bicycles or e-bikes, which are regulated by UK legislation and British Standards.

Staff Abuse

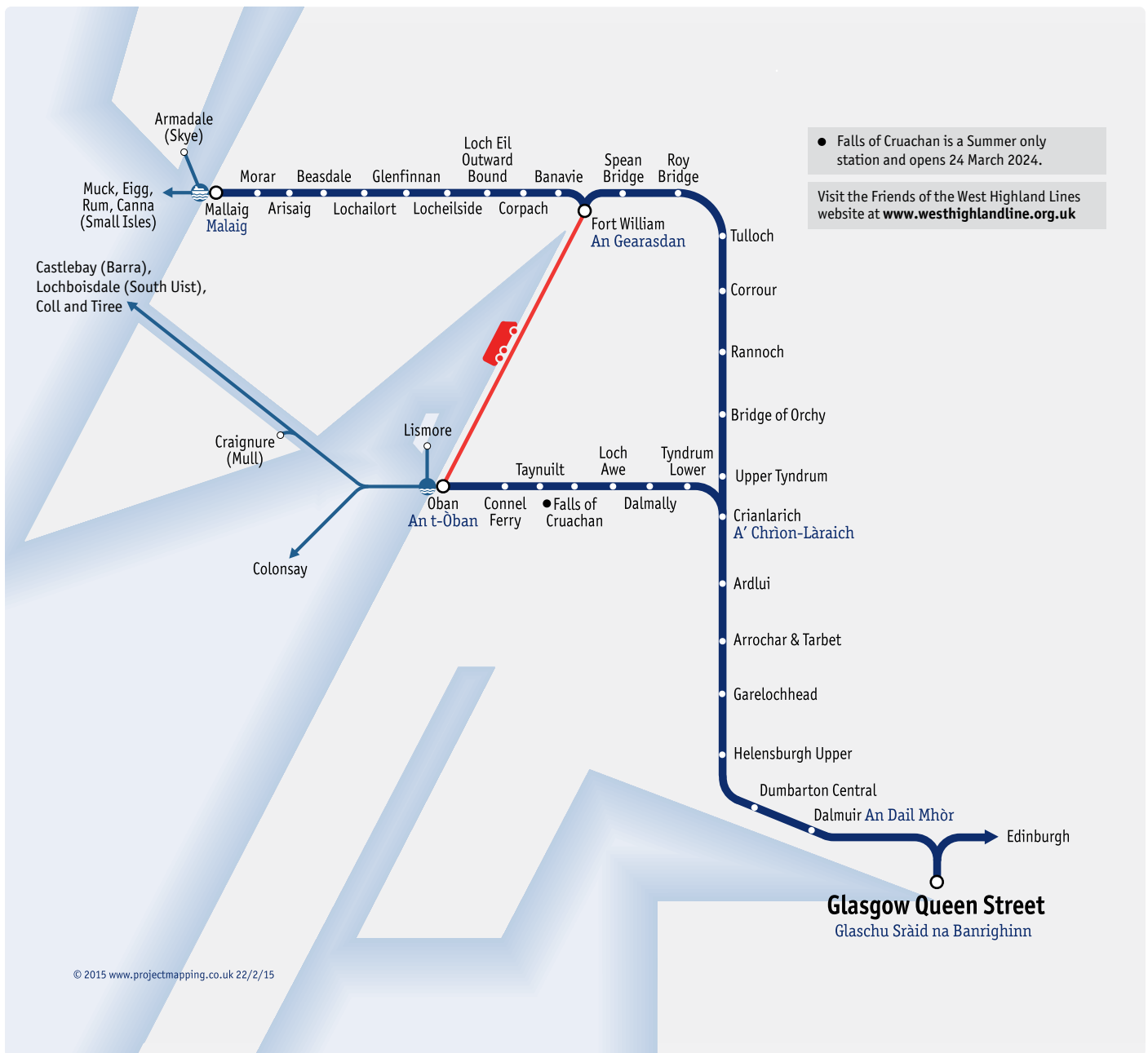
