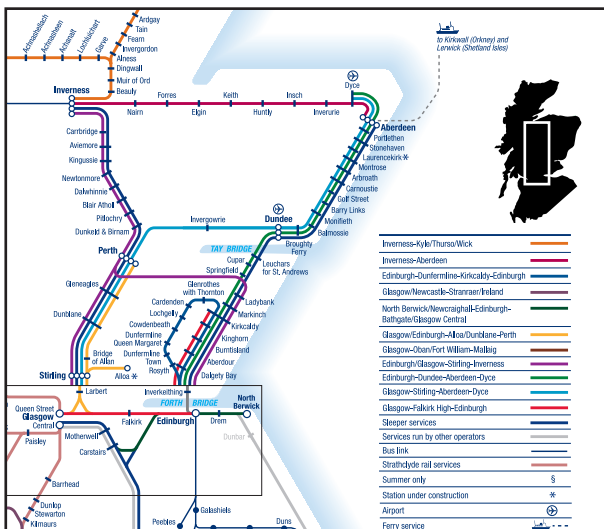

Welcome to our 2007-2008 Winter Timetable

First ScotRail is delighted to announce a number of enhancements to our services during this timetable period.

Sunday services will be introduced for the Glasgow to Larkhall via Hamilton line and the Glasgow to Stirling via Croy route.



The Glasgow-Larkhall hourly services will build on the resounding success of the first new branch line in Scotland for 25 years and allow the new stations at Larkhall, Merryton and Chatelherault to open for the first time on Sundays. The hourly Glasgow-Stirling enhancement will provide our customers in Bishopbriggs with all year round Sunday services and offer more travel opportunities from other stations on the route.

The last service from Edinburgh to Glasgow via Shotts will now call at Uddingston and Cambuslang on Mondays to Saturdays.

These additions are part of our focus on customer service and any alterations in the timetable are designed to improve reliability and ensure a value for money service.

We are pleased to reintroduce a number of services which had to be withdrawn during Network Rail's intensive engineering works for the £150million redevelopment of Edinburgh Waverley Station.

They include Newcraighall-Bathgate-Dunblane through services. All Fife Circle services will now continue to Edinburgh Waverley rather than terminate at Haymarket and a full timetable is being reinstated between Edinburgh and West Calder. A number of other services to and from Edinburgh Waverley will be subject to minor retimings.

Our timetable includes minor retimings which are intended to improve punctuality on the Paisley Canal Line and on some West Highland Line services between Glasgow, Oban and Fort William.

As Scotland's key transport provider, we are committed to providing a safe, reliable and punctual service and will continue to welcome your views through our regular Meet the Manager sessions.

Information

Buying your ticket

To avoid any queues, you can buy your ticket in advance by calling our Telesales team on 08457 55 00 33 between 0700 and 2200. All major credit cards and charge cards are accepted. Alternatively, you can buy your ticket online at www.firstscotrail.com

Seat reservations

Reservations are free when you buy a ticket to travel on First ScotRail. It's always wise to try to book your seat. Reservations are available on many of our trains, particularly on longer routes. First Class accommodation between Glasgow / Edinburgh and Inverness is limited and seat reservations are recommended.

Transfers

If you're changing trains at a station on this route, please allow at least five minutes for your transfer, 10 minutes at Edinburgh or Glasgow Queen Street, and 30 minutes for the cross town transfer between Glasgow Queen St. and Glasgow Central (a special cross town bus service is available free to valid ticket holders). Connecting bus services for Edinburgh Airport run to and from Edinburgh, Haymarket and Inverkeithing stations.

Trains on this route

All services in this timetable are operated by First ScotRail unless otherwise shown. Most First ScotRail services convey First and Standard Class accommodation and a catering service, unless otherwise shown. Trains may divide en route - please check with staff that you are in the correct portion. Trains may be longer than some of the platforms at stations on this route. Before alighting, please make sure that the station platform is immediately adjacent. All First ScotRail services are non-smoking.

Parking your car

Park and Ride facilities are available at all stations on this route, **except** Edinburgh Waverley and Larbert. Passengers with a valid rail ticket can park at stations on the day of travel. Parking charges apply at Aviemore, Glasgow Queen Street, Haymarket, Inverness, Perth, Pitlochry and Stirling.

Rail and Bus through tickets

If your final destination is not rail connected, First ScotRail might still be able to help. We operate PlusBus and RailBus ticket schemes with many bus operators all around Scotland. Just one ticket from First ScotRail can include your onward bus travel.

Plusbus and RailBus destinations in the area of this timetable include Alloa, Callander, Doune, Crieff, Edinburgh, Edinburgh Airport, Falkirk Grahamston, Glasgow, Glasgow International Airport, Inverness. Larbert and Perth; but tickets are available to destinations all around Scotland. Through rail tickets are also available to Glasgow Subway stations.

PlusBus and RailBus tickets are available from staffed stations, from First ScotRail Telesales, or on-train if you start your journey from a station with
