
KEEPING YOU MOVING

GLASGOW QUEEN STREET TUNNEL CLOSURE From 20 March 2016 – Re-opening 8 August 2016



For travel to/from Glasgow, please use services via Bathgate and Airdrie to Glasgow Queen Street Low Level. This journey takes around 70 minutes and is your fastest option.

For intermediate stations, please travel via Falkirk High, which diverts after Croy to reach Glasgow Queen Street Low Level. Journeys will take around 25 minutes longer.

There are also trains to Glasgow Central via Shotts/Motherwell.

Queuing systems will be in place - particularly at peak times - and station staff will guide you to the next train.

To accommodate diverted services, there will be changes to other trains across the country.

Services may be retimed and the final destination may be different from the train you usually go for.

Please check your own journey – and its final destination - before travelling.
