
KEEPING YOU MOVING

GLASGOW QUEEN STREET TUNNEL CLOSURE From 20 March 2016 – Re-opening 8 August 2016



Services to/from Glasgow Queen Street High Level will be diverted to Glasgow Queen Street Low Level station or Glasgow Central. This means journeys will take between 20-40 minutes longer.

Queuing systems will be in place, particularly at peak times and a one way system for accessing and exiting low level platforms will be in operation:

Platform 8 - for trains to Milngavie, Helensburgh, Balloch, Stirling, Alloa, Perth:

- Enter the station/join queues via North Hanover Street
- Exit the station via Dundas Street

Platform 9 - for trains to Edinburgh, Airdrie, Bathgate, Cumbernauld, West Highlands:

- Enter the station/join queues via Dundas Street
- Exit the station via North Hanover Street

There may be some exceptions to this arrangement, but station staff will guide you.

In addition, to accommodate diverted trains, there will be <u>changes to other services across the</u> <u>country</u>. Trains may be retimed and the final destination may be different from the train you usually get.
