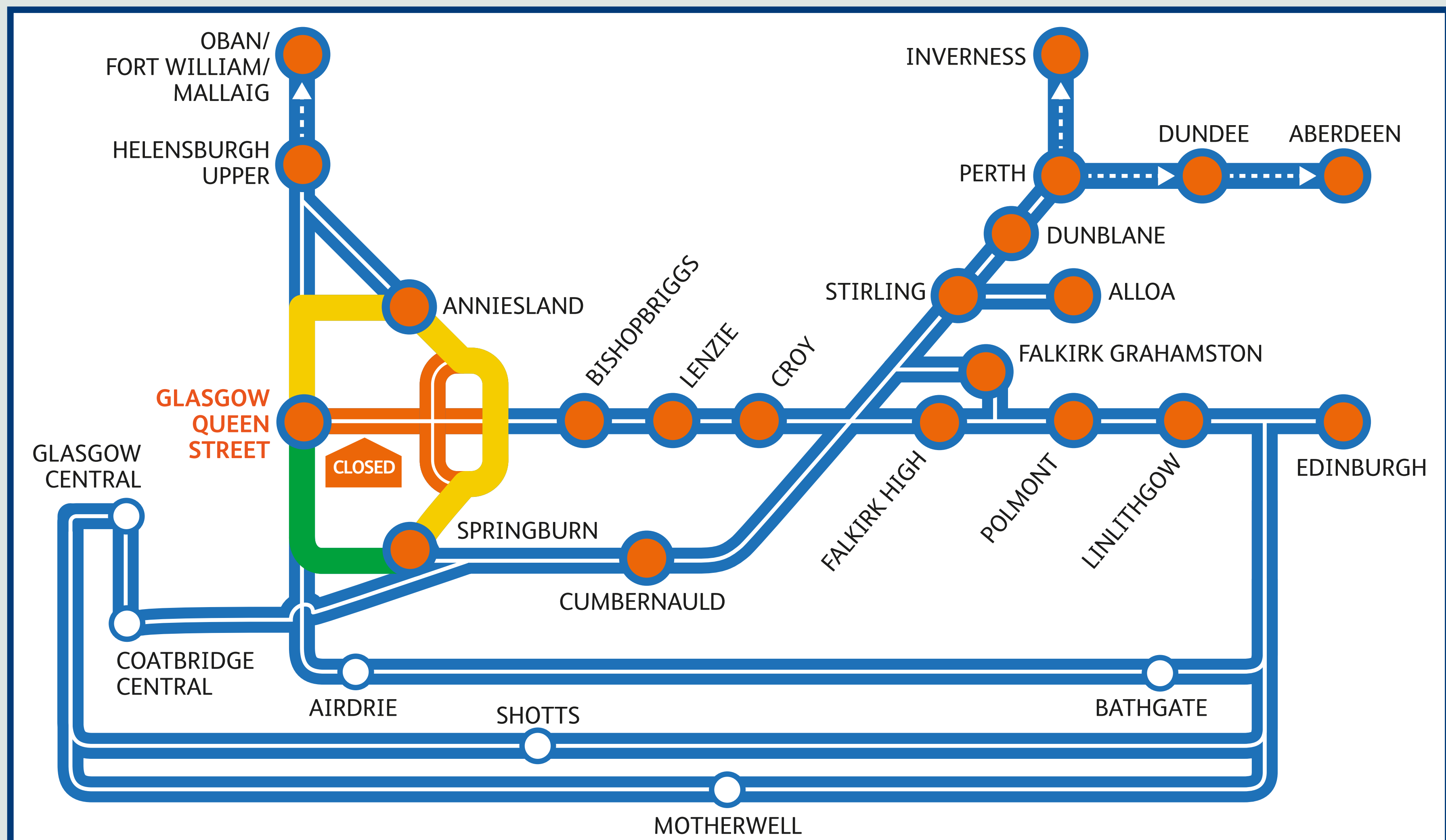


KEEPING YOU MOVING

GLASGOW QUEEN STREET TUNNEL CLOSURE

From 20 March 2016 – Re-opening 8 August 2016



During the closure, Anniesland and Falkirk Grahamston routes will be combined. One train per hour will run via Cumbernauld and Springburn.

Monday to Saturday: passengers will have a choice of how to travel:

- Go west towards Anniesland and change trains to reach Glasgow Queen Street Low Level
- Catch an eastbound train towards Falkirk Grahamston and change trains at Springburn for Glasgow Queen Street Low Level

Customers should check which opportunity gives them a shorter journey time.

Sunday: services will operate between Ashfield and Anniesland only. Passengers heading to Glasgow should travel west to Anniesland and change trains to reach Glasgow Queen Street.

Tip: Select a date between 20 March and 7 August.

Note: Fast and frequent buses run to Glasgow from Maryhill Road (opposite Kirn Street). For timings, visit travelinescotland.com
